Household dues include up to two (2) adults and all children who live at the same residence. Children must be under the age of 18 or a college student (ages 18-25) with a valid college I.D. New membership cards may be picked up at the front desk. **Membership is non-refundable.**

Nannies and Au Pairs: age 18-25 with note from sponsoring agency, or employer if non-agency.

CREDITS/REFUNDS

- **Available only during the first two weeks of the term and will be pro-rated from the time of the request -- which must be in writing.** Forms are available at the Front Desk.
- After the second week of the term, refunds are given only with a valid medical excuse from a physician.
- Credits and refunds may be donated to The Connection or applied toward a next class or membership and may be used by a family member.
- All credits expire one year from date of issuance.
- Pre-authorized credit card charges may be cancelled in writing with 30 days notice, and will not be given retroactively.
- The Connection reserves the right to make certain programs and events non-refundable.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Financial assistance is available for classes and activities. Forms are available at the Front Desk and should be completed one week before registration. Please call Jacqueline Fernandez 908-273-4242, x134 for further information.

LATE REGISTRATION

Fees will be pro-rated after the second week of classes.

CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP

Group membership plans are offered to groups of employees from area businesses, schools, fire and police departments, and other organizations. Groups of five or more receive a 10% discount.

MISSED CLASSES

In the event of a class cancellation by The Connection due to safety or weather related reasons or instructor illness, members will be offered a pass to Jump In & Swim, Drop In & Play, Recreational Swim or a Daily Facility pass. Make-up classes are not offered to members who miss classes.

BABYSITTING

The Connection provides babysitting from 8:30am to 6:30pm for children of parents enrolled in classes, using the facility or attending meetings of Connection committees. Ages 6 months and up are welcome at a charge of \$3 per hour, with a one-hour minimum. **Total Facility members receive free babysitting care while using the facilities.** Participants pay for babysitting at the front desk before dropping off children. Nursery availability is dependent upon space.
