




#### **COMMUNITY SERVICE**

We hosted **71 students from 20 countries** in our English as a Second
Language Program.



#### **VOLUNTEER**

**86 volunteers** assisted across our multitude of community service programs.

Our 2023 Connection Gala raised \$335,000 to support our Community Service and Financial Aid Fund.



#### **SCHOLARSHIP**
